Kissimmee auction to feature first production Firebirds

The massive Mecum auction held in Kissimmee, Florida each year is planned for Jan. 7-16. The auction company reports it will have 3,500 cars on hand to go across the auction block. Two of those will be 1967 Pontiac Firebird #001 and #002, both restored and owned by Richard Rawlings, host of the *Fast n'Loud* show on Discovery

channel. Firebird #001 is a red/red convertible with a column shift and 326 Cl motor. The car has 80,389 miles (est.) and the auction company expects a buy between \$175,000-\$225,000. Firebird #002 is a silver/black hardtop with a 4 speed and L76 H0 326 Cl motor with 58,000 miles. Mecum expects that car will bring \$115,000-\$135,000.

their garage to us and Mike Jewell and the GTO Club for providing a great lunch!






Cactus GTO Club donates \$400 to Toyz for Totz
