

Mark was the former owner of the McDonalds restaurant at the Pavilions in Scottsdale. Several decades ago Mark started a Saturday night car gathering near his beloved McDonalds. That first Saturday, 7 cars showed up, but within a few months the numbers had continued to grow and the cars eventually grew into the hundreds.



There were Saturdays during the year when that number grew to well over 1,000 maybe even 2,000 vehicles and thousands of spectators as well. Mark loved putting on these every Saturday car gatherings and loved seeing the cars, but mainly he liked meeting and getting to know the vehicle owners.

He also loved supporting and donating to the Ronald McDonald House. Several nice checks were presented to the local Ronald McDonald House coordinator and thehat was passed through the crowd and even more money was collected during the evening ceremony. As the years flew by, this world-famous Car Show became known as the Rock N Roll Car Show at the Pavilions. Just about any Car Guy or Car Gal living or visiting in the area has been there.

Sadly, we lost Mark during the shut-down time of Covid 19 and the car show was also lost during that time. Thankfully, the De Rito Partners that own and operate the sprawling Pavilions complex along with many of the business owners there, wanted the cars to return.

So they contacted Larry Oliver and convinced him to organize the Saturday events and get them rolling again. So, thanks to the De Rito Partners and Larry's hard work, the Rock N Roll Pavilions Car Show in Scottsdale is again attracting hundreds of Cool and Unique, Muscle Cars, Sports Cars, Trucks, Hot Rods, Classics, even some Rat Rods, and a Race Car or two, plus, they have a special parking area for the Motorcycles as well.

The new Mark Kramer Memorial Plaque is now on permanent display in the large parking lot right next to the McDonalds that Mark used to own. The FREE Saturday Car Shows are from 4:pm to 8:pm.
