2023 Racing Series Overview

The fast-growing Outlaw Pontiac Racer West series has just released its initial slate of 2023 race dates. All Pontiac-powered and Pontiac-bodied cars, regardless of their engine type, are welcomed.

"This year's big news is that we're adding a Las Vegas race which will also include an all-Pontiac car show that's held at the Las Vegas Speedway," according to Outlaw series coordinator and POCI member **Rick Unterseh**. "Pontiacs at the Strip" will be a 'subevent' of the huge Muscle Cars at the Strip multi-make gathering and race."

In addition to the mid-March Las Vegas gig, confirmed race dates include:

Las Vegas (March 17-19)

Phoenix (Apr 29, May 20)

Barona, CA (Nov 18)

"Even more dates will be announced pending ongoing negotiations, including the track at Irwindale, California," Rick continued.
