## **Message from the President**

We heard about a tragic loss this month from club member Mark Delano. Mark has spent the last 20+ years in the Valley restoring GTOs for club members and to fill his own garage. During the week of August 14, Mark had spent the night working in his shop. Apparently, after closing up the shop for the night, smoldering hot metal started a fire in the garage. Mark and wife Debbie awoke to see fire com-

ing through the roof of the garage (neighbors had

already called the fire department).





Because of all the flammables in the garage, they had to let the fire burn itself out, destroying everything inside.

Fortunately, no one was hurt. But Mark lost two of his own GTOs—a 1970 GTO Judge and a rarely optioned 455 H.O. hardtop, plus parts, tools, and his collectibles. The garage itself was destroyed. Club member Dave Campbell also lost a 1969 GTO Judge and a 1970 455 H.O. convertible in the fire.

Both guys had limited insurance on the cars; Mark is hoping to collect some money from the loss of the building, but it will not cover the cost for rebuilding the garage. Many of us in the club have known Mark for his honesty and great workmanship. He knows his Pontiacs and always goes the extra mile for his customers.

All four of my previous and current Pontiacs have benefited from his workmanship.

Now it's our turn to go the extra mile. At our Sept.8 meeting, we will have a fundraiser for the Delanos to help them recover their loss. Bring your cash and your checkbooks. Help a fellow GTO enthusiast get back on his feet. Mark plans on getting back into GTO restoration – slowly buy surely. He needs our help now.
